THE “SILVER LIST” AND THE “GOLDEN LIST”

The original “Golden List” – historical Salvatorian events of interest to the world-wide Salvatorian Family – was published in 2011 by the International Historical Commission. It outlined the main Salvatorian historical events for the next 25 years.

With that in mind, the USA Joint History & Charism Committee put together what we called the “Silver List” – historical Salvatorian events that happened here in the United States which would be of interest to the USA Salvatorian Family. *(Some exact dates are unknown, but the events are noted in the correct year.)*

We’ve decided to combine those lists here on our website to draw our attention to ALL the upcoming Salvatorian events – both national and international – for the coming decade. This way we can keep track of what we are commemorating with a single list. The items below in Bold & Italic print are from the original “Golden List.” – And now: introducing **“Silver and Gold!”** Below is the list of events for the decade **2023-2032**.

2023 –

- 175 years** ***BIRTH OF BLESSED FRANCIS JORDAN - Jun 16, 1948***
- 150 years Death of Fr. Ambrose Oswald, founder of St. Nazianz - Feb 27, 1873
- 100 years Elkton, MD - Opening of Salvatorian Mission House - 1923
- 100 years Milwaukee, WI - Open Burleigh Street house (beginnings of MGC) - Dec 5, 1923
- 75 years Blackwood, NJ - Opening of Mother of the Savior Seminary - Sep 1948

2024 –

- 75 years Menominee, MI - Second Opening of Jordan Seminary (after WWII) - 1949
- 75 years Salvatorians forced to close missions in Fukien, China by the Communists - 1949
- 50 years Racine, WI - Closing of Dominican College (The College of Racine) – 1974

2025 –

- 125 years Laying of cornerstone of St. Mary’s Convent, Milwaukee – May 27, 1900

2026 –

- 100 years Mother of Good Counsel Parish opens first church building - 1926
- 100 years SDS-M Anglo-American Province becomes North American Province - 1926
- 100 years SDS-M Novitiate moves from St. Nazianz, WI to Elkton, MD - 1926
(Scholasticate sent to look for housing in Washington, DC)
- 100 years** ***Final Approval of the Sisters’ Constitutions - Apr 27, 1926***
- 100 years SDS-W North American Province Established - Jul 30, 1926
- 100 years Divine Savior High School opens in Milwaukee, WI - Sep 27, 1926

2027 –

- 100 years Washington DC - SDS-M Scholasticate on Monroe Street opens - Sep 15, 1927
75 years Blackwood, NJ - St. Pius X House of Retreats opens – 1952
50 years Galt, CA - Closing of St. Pius X Seminary – 1977

2028 –

- 150 years** *Fr. Jordan's Ordination - Jul 21, 1878*
75 years Wauwatosa, WI - St. Pius X Parish opens – 1953

2029 –

- 125 years First American Sisters profess vows - Nov 3, 1904
75 years SDS-M Leave Macao peninsula in China – 1954

2030 –

- 75 years SDS-M arrive in Tanganyika (Tanzania) - Jun 5, 1955
75 years Rio Dell, CA - Opening of St. Pius X Seminary – Sep 1955
(for Sacramento Diocese under SDS supervision)
75 years Rio Dell, CA - Christmas Day Flood isolates St. Pius X Seminary - Dec 25, 1955

2031 –

- 150 years** *Foundation of the Apostolic Teaching Society - Dec 8, 1881*
75 years Columbus, GA - SDS-M open St. Benedict the Moor Parish - 1956
(an all-Black parish)
75 years Huntsville, AL - Opening of St. Joseph School - 1956
(in predominantly Black St. Joseph Parish which opened in 1952)
75 years Sioux City, IA - Opening of Trinity Prep Seminary - Sep 1956

2032 –

- 150 years** *Mother Mary professes First Vows in Apostolic Teaching Society – Sep 5, 1882*
125 years SDS-W Novitiate Established in United States - Jan 24, 1907
125 years *DEATH OF MOTHER MARY - Dec 25, 1907*
100 years Menominee, MI - Opening of Jordan College – 1932
75 years SDS-W arrive in Tanganyika (Tanzania) – 1957
50 years St. Nazianz, WI - Closing of JFK Prep - Jan 1982
